REPORT FROM THE BOARD OF MANAGERS OF ST DA-VID'S PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

FOR YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2023

I would like to thank everyone for helping to keep the church running smoothly over the past year.

The complex has been maintained to a high standard with the WOF from the Otorohanga District Council being issued after the Exit Light was repaired to the requirement of Zerofire Safety Ltd Hamilton. Zerofire Safety Ltd checks the building monthly and advises if anything needs to be repaired. The existing Exit Light backup batteries are now unavailable, so we must replace the whole new Exit Light system. There are a further seven Exit Lights to replace when they fail.

Tidy Gardens Ltd has kept our gardens tidy, with GMS mowing our lawns regularly.

The Manse rental is going well under the management of Michelle from Harcourts. There was a cost of \$11307 to bring the Manse up to the Healthy Living Government standard for renting and since then there have been repairs to the hot water system to increase the pressure in the shower.

Our website **www.saintdavids.org.nz** was developed by KS Design of Otorohanga and kindly donated by Ann Roberts. This went live in March 2023.
